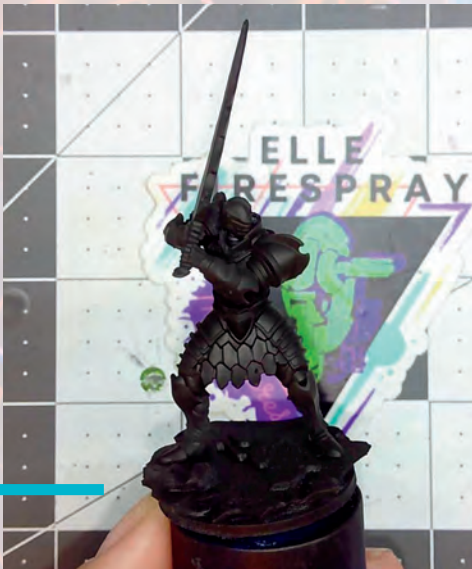


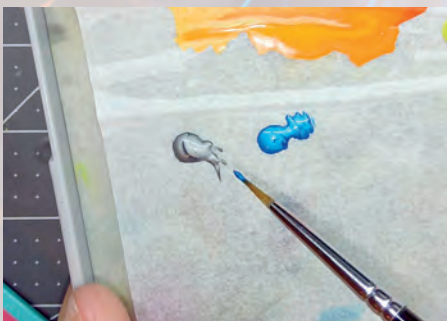
STORMLIGHT ARCHIVE PAINTING SERIES

SHARDBEARER

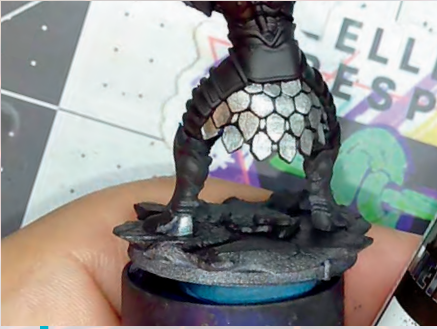

We primed our miniature in black. We will be using generic names for the paints, or alternative names from the colours of the Army Painter set in this tutorial.



To create the blue tint of the armour, mix a bit of Windrunner blue or metallic blue with a dark silver.



Apply the metallic colour carefully, try to avoid the recesses so they remain black and create more contrast.



It would end up looking something like this.



For the Blade, use a very bright silver such as Shardblade Silver. I'm using Chrome paint for this.

If you want to make the armour even more blue, I'd recommend using something like 5-6 drops of Gloss Varnish and 1-2 drops of Blue Intensity Ink and glaze over the miniature.



For the teal visor, paint the slots in white first, and then add turquoise or Windrunner blue on top. Leave the rocks black and dry brush with a light grey.

And now our Shardbearer is complete!
